Dear Current or Prospective Student,

The Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA) of 2008 and our institutional accreditation agency require that Institutions make available to their students information regarding graduation and employment rates, including the methodology and time frame applicable to the rates.

To follow is the 2025 annual report graduation rate, employment rate, and licensure/certification examination pass rate data for the school. This information is required to be disclosed for the 2026 calendar year. Please understand that each year the annual reports are due near the end of the calendar year. As a result, the rates disclosed for the current year are from the previous year's submitted annual report. Disclosures are updated within a reasonable timeframe after the submission date.

This information is compiled based on the requirements of our institutional accrediting body. Information is maintained, tracked, and updated in our student database system.

The methodology and time frame applicable to these rates is as follows:

Institutional Accrediting Body: Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC)

The annual report covers the period from July 1 through June 30. Graduation and employment statistics are calculated per program. Employment rate and licensure/certification exam pass rate benchmarks are a minimum 70% per program. The graduation benchmark varies by program and is based on the program length.

Although the annual report covers the period from July 1 through June 30, the dates used for the calculation will cover class start dates prior to this period. The dates are determined based on program length in months and allow for students to complete the program within 1.5 times the program length and 3 months to find employment. The class start dates used to calculate the rates for each program have been included below.

Graduation rates are calculated by dividing total graduates by students available for graduation. Employment rates are calculated by dividing employed graduates by total available graduates for the reporting period. Licensure/certification exam rates are calculated by dividing the total graduates who passed the exam by the total graduates who have taken the exam.

Employed students are defined as a graduate who obtained sustainable employment that is directly related to the program from which the individual graduated, aligns with a majority of the educational and training objectives of the program, and is a paid position. Employment information is verified with the employer.

The licensure/certification exam rates listed below are for programs that may require licensure or certification to obtain employment. The pass rate listed below is the rate as last reported to ACCSC. This rate may not represent the most recent calendar year pass rate and is based on the class cohorts displayed below. If you have questions regarding your program's pass rate, please consult with the Dean of Education.

As per ACCSC standards, the rates listed below may exclude students who fall into one of the following categories: death, incarceration, active military service deployment, the onset of a medical condition that prevents continued enrollment or employment, or international students who are enrolled on the basis of a student or work visa and are ineligible for sustainable employment in the United States post-graduation.
